## Debris Box Sizes

Size Matters! Choosing the right size debris box is important. Opting for a debris box that too small for the job will require extra services and costs.


14 Ft. Length $\times 8$ Ft. Wide $\times 2$ Ft. Height


15 Ft . Length $\times 8 \mathrm{Ft}$. Wide $\times 4 \mathrm{Ft}$. Height


18 Ft . Length $\times 8$ Ft. Wide $\times 4 \mathrm{Ft}$. Height


18 Ft. Length $\times 8$ Ft. Wide $\times 6$ Ft. Height

8-CUBIC YARD BOX
Used for junk removal, very small renovation projects and the removal of dirt, sod, brick, rock, cinder block, asphalt and concrete.

## 15-CUBIC YARD BOX

Used for small demolition projects*, roofing, garage cleanouts, whole-home flooring removal, renovation, and additions.

20-CUBIC YARD BOX
Used for larger-scale projects such as large attic, shed, basement, and garage cleanouts; large bathroom or kitchen remodeling or renovation; and removal of large amounts of construction and demolition material.*

30-CUBIC YARD BOX
Used for major projects to dispose of large amounts of construction and demolition material*, large garage and home renovations or additions, new home construction and large structural builds and whole-house clean-outs.
*Please note: disposal of heavy materials, such as dirt, sod, brick, and concrete, are limited to the 8 -cubic yard box size.
