Debris Box Service Application New Customer Peninsula Sanitary Service, Inc.

All debris box customers will be required to pay a pre-payment for the initial delivery of every new box
- Pre-payment will be equal to the pull rate for the size of the box ordered

BILLING INCLUDES: a Placement Fee, Per Pull Charge, and Tonnage Charge for each pick up. **If the container is not picked up in thirty days, a demurrage charge will be applied each day until service is scheduled. (Fees are outlined on the attached rate document).** The pickup and tonnage fees are taken out of the pre-payment. If there is a balance owed, PSSI will invoice you at the end of the billing cycle. If a refund is due, a check will be sent within 30 days of the last day of the billing cycle. **PLEASE NOTE: CONTAMINATED LOADS WILL BE CHARGED HANDLING FEES ACCORDINGLY AND DEPENDING ON THE TYPE AND VOLUME OF CONTAMINATION, MAY NOT BE SERVICED AT ALL.**

PAYMENT: You may pay by company check, personal check, money order, credit card (Visa, MasterCard, & Discover) or cash (no third- party checks).

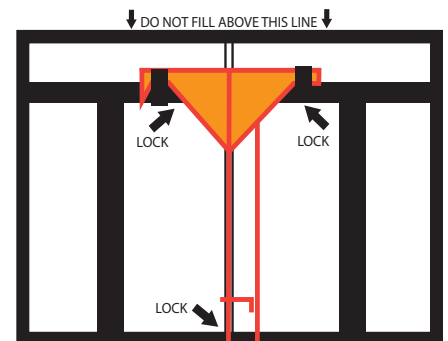
DELIVERY/PICKUP: Please schedule service 24 hours in advance, before 1 pm the day before service is needed. Requests made after 1 pm may be subject to a fee. Don't forget to include if the box is to be picked up with no return. If the driver is unable to access your container to service, you may be billed an hourly standby fee.

PLEASE REMEMBER: NO HAZARDOUS WASTE IN BOX. MATERIAL CANNOT BE HIGHER THAN THE EDGE OF THE BOX. PSSI WILL NOT HAUL OVERLOADED OR OVERFULL BOXES.

No tires, televisions, computer monitors, refrigerators or items containing Freon, oil or hazardous materials are accepted. If the landfill finds these items in your container, you will be billed the landfill fee.

CLOSING BOX: Please make sure the T-bar is fully locked into top and bottom channel locks (as indicated by arrows at right) when closing box. We cannot pick up the box if these are not locked correctly.

CONTAMINATION: Loads characterized as contaminated (i.e., trash in organics, etc.) by the landfill - shall be charged at loose garbage rates (Fees are outlined in the attached document). Contaminated boxes will not be returned to the Customer's site to be offloaded - boxes will be dumped at the landfill. Customer will not be notified of load characterization change.

The undersigned also acknowledges, and waives to the maximum extent permitted by law any rights or benefits the undersigned may have under, Section 1542 of the California Civil Code, which provides as follows:

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him or her must have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor."
